

## Special Circumstance Qualifying Meet Policy

Griffith Swimming Club has prepared this Policy to communicate the circumstances under which a member of the GSC may seek to request a Special Circumstance Qualifying Meet and the requirements that must be met for approval of such request.

The request is to be submitted to the Griffith Swimming Club President via email with the below Information president@griffithswimclub.org.au

- 1. Meet Name:

- 3. Event:
- 4. Current Official Time: (\*achieved within 3months of the request)
- 5. Qualifying Time Required:

## Approval is conditional on the below requirements

- No meets within the SISA area are scheduled to be held between the request and closing date for the Meet
- Swimmer must be within the below times of the required Qualifying time for any event
  - a. 50m 1 second or less
  - b. 100m 1.5 seconds or less
  - c. 200m 2 seconds or less
  - d. 400m and above 4 seconds or less

## **Procedure Information**

- The event will be conducted in terms of the Rules of Swimming
- Approval of the request is dependent on SISA approval and the availability of Officials
- All entries into a Special Circumstance Qualifying Meet are to be approved at the discretion of the Referee. This
  is inclusive of the swimmer/s who have made the request and any swimmer who is requesting permission to
  enter with an already achieved qualifying time but is seeking to record an improved official time
- The Committee or Officials are not required to notify all members of a requested or approved Special Circumstance Qualifying Meet
- Any swimmer that enters a Special Circumstance Qualifying Meet must do so via Swim Central and be approved prior by the Referee

This Policy was created on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2022 in consideration of supporting our members and swimmers in consultation with Griffith Swimming Club Officials and Life Members and can be reviewed as required.
